CHAMPAGNE

Champagne de Castelnau:

Located in the heart of Reims, Champagne de Castelnau dates back to 1916 when it was created in honour of the celebrated First World War veteran General de Castelnau. This multi award winning Champagne house is lead by Elisabeth Sarcelet, one of just a handful of female Chef de Caves in the region.

1. Champagne De Castelnau Brut N/V - France

Lively but gentle with the stone fruit notes more clearly defined as hints of apricot, white peach and wild peaches. The spontaneity and charm of this Brut Champagne make it a natural temptation anytime, day or night.

2. Champagne De Castelnau Rose N/V - France

Notes of sweets and crystallised fruits linger, lifted by a touch of eau-de-vie of cherries from the Pinot Noir as befits a true rosé.

3. Champagne De Castelnau Brut Reserve - France

The initial aromas are intriguing as they show a complexity rarely present in a non-vintage Brut, which are lovely spicy, herbaceous tones of thyme and dried flowers. The palate is intense showing faintly honeyed notes of Gingerbread, almonds and hazelnuts blended with peach and ripe apricot. This award winning cuvée is best described as having the soul of a vintage wine in the body of a non-vintage.

4. Moet & Chandon Brut - France

Still the best selling Non-Vintage Champagne in the UK, this classic blend boasts notes of green apple and citrus fruits.

6. Champagne De Castelnau Vintage 2002 - France

Delicate notes of spice on the nose giving way to a richer, more generous and more voluptuous impression on the palate than expected, with hints of citrus, almond, and baked fruit. The structure is warm and open, with a nice, lifted, faintly toasty note on the finish. This strikingly elegant and refined example from the exceptional 2002 vintage demonstrates the true de Castelnau house style.

11. Meursault Villes Vignes Domaine Guy Bocard - Burgundy

Guy Bocards motto is if you can taste the oak I've used to much this is a rich tropical journey refined and elegant all the way.

Lightly oak retaining butterscotch and hazelnuts hints, finishes with complex flavours of brioche and cinnamon.

17. Bodegas Ramon Bilbao Gran Reserva Rioja - Rioja

An outstanding mature Rioja, with hints of blackcurrant fruit on the nose and a wonderful rich vanilla oak character.

18. Amarone DOC Zeni - Italy

This wine which boasts an ancient tradition, is still made in small quantities from the best red grapes of the Valpolicella district, picked and left to dry on rafters until late winter. The wine is full bodied and velvety smooth with complex aromas of violets, raspberries and mint blossom.

19. Chateau Teyssier Saint Emilion Grand CRU - Bordeaux

A colour of dark garnet red with subtle shades of Purple. The nose is complex and fruity with aromas of blackcurrants. The taste is supple and well balanced with undertones of liquorice and blackberries.

20. Chateauneuf Du Pape Domaine Du Grand Tinel - Rhone

This famous wine is produced from 50 year old vines grown on pebble strewn slopes, to give rich and powerful aromas of wild herbs and cedar backed by bold flavours of cherry, strawberry and prune.

21. Geoff Merrill Cabernet Sauvignon G & W Coonawarra - Coonawarra

The aroma shows intense varietal characters with subtle complex oak in the background. Wonderfully supple palate with excellent structure.

22. Whistling Duck Semillon Sauvignon Blanc - Australia

This blend brings together the fragrant grassy notes of Sauvignon Blanc and the citrus tropical aromas of Semillon - the palate is soft and fresh with balanced acidity.

This wine is a wonderful reflection of the Cortese grape variety. It is fruity and aromatic with just a hint of mineral notes and a mouth watering citrus finish.
