Galanti Spumante Rosé ~ Italy £26.50 Light, carnation-pink coloured rose with generous raspberry and strawberry fruit both on the nose and palate. 3. Villa Conchi Brut Reserva, Cava ~ Spain £29.00 125ml £5.50 Elegant with fine bubbles. Good intensity with fruit aromas and toasted nuances. Fresh, warm, pleasant and round, with a long finish. £41.00 4. Bottega Gold Prosecco Brut ~ Italy Made from Glera grapes, grown in the Valdobbiadene hills which are hand-picked and gently pressed in the winery. The must obtained is fermented in for nearly 40 days, at about 15° C, with the addition of selected yeasts. £50.00 5. Louis Dornier et Fils Brut ~ France 125ml £10.00 Upfront biscuity elegance blends with a respectful ageing in bottle. Altogether a very stylish wine. £87.50 6. Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut ~ France Reflecting the traditions of the past, this is full, yet dry and has a rich, creamy style with biscuity flavours. 7. Dom Perignon Brut ~ France £185.00 A classic from one of the finest Champagne Houses in France. White Wine 8. El Velero Verdejo Blanco Albali, Valdepeñas ~ Spain £18.50 175ml £4.90 The Verdejo grape is an aromatic variety, shows green apple and citrus fruit on the palate with floral 250ml £6.30 notes on the finish. £19.25 9. Altoritas Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley ~ Chile 175ml £5.05 Light, herbaceous aromas, coupled with lemon on the dry, refreshing palate 250ml £6.75 10. Hardys Mill Cellars Chardonnay ~ South Eastern Australia £20.50 175ml £5.50 A fruit-filled Chardonnay with a very light touch of oak contact and bottled early to retain the 250ml £7.20 freshness. Fresh, citrusy flavours on the nose and palate backed by crisp acidity on the finish £22.00 11. Antonio Rubini Pinot Grigio delle Venezie ~ Italy 175ml £5.70 The Pinot Grigio grapes used to make this wine were grown in the Pavia region, not far from Milan. 250ml £7.50 Shows apple and pear with hints of white peach and elderflower. £23.50 12. Kleine Zalze Cellar Selection Bush Vines Chenin Blanc, Coastal Region ~ South Africa 175ml £5.95 Low-yielding ild 'bush vines' planted on the Knorhoek Farm's vineyards on the lower slopes of the 250ml £7.95 towring Simonsberg Mountain produce this ripe, tropical-fruit flavoured Chenin Blanc. Some less ageing and partial malolactic fermentation help to both soften and round the finish. 13. Vine Trail Gewurtztranimer, Curicó Valley ~ Chile £24.50 A dry Gewürztraminer, with just a touch of richness; well-balanced showing classic notes of orange blossom, lychee and rose followed by a fresh finish. 14. Waipara Hills Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough ~ New Zealand £27.50 175ml £6.95 A generous and lifted style, showing powerful aromas of melon, nettle and snow pea; the palate 250ml £9.25 bursts with fresh citrus, grapefruit and melon notes, the fruit carrying through to the aromatic finish. £29.00 15. Rare Vineyards Marsanne-Viognier, Pays d'Oc ~ France Soft and aromatic with notes of peach blossom and citrus on the deliciously refreshing finish. 16. Feudi Salentini 125 Malvasia del Salento ~ Italy £33.00 Straw-yellow with golden hints; it shows tropical and grapey fruit flavours, with notes of almond, apricot and blossom. 17. Touraine Sauvignon, Domaine Trotignon ~ France £36.00 Made entirely from Viura grapes, cool-fermented in stainless steel tanks and bottled young to preserve maximum aromas and crispness. 18. Chablis, Vignerons de Chablis ~ France £42.00 175ml £10.65 Fresh, lively with a citrus and white blossom character backed by a finish tinged with minerality. The 250ml £14.50 Chardonnay grapes are harvested at the optimum moment, and cool fermented in stainless steel prior

to a period of rest and intergration before bottling.
