CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

Beaumont des Crayeres 'Grande Reserve', Champagne, France ^V

Pale golden and expressive. Pear and grapefruit enhanced by subtle bread dough and flinty notes. Greengage and citrus and fine acidity make for a long and complex finish. (1)

Billecart-Salmon, Brut Réserve, Champagne, France

Light and elegant, citrus and baked apple on the nose with delicate floral touches on the palate along with a fine biscuity richness. (1)

Amori Prosecco Extra Dry, Veneto, Italy ^V

This classic Prosecco has an aromatic nose, refreshing acidity and is very soft on the palate. Lots of mouth-filling tropical fruit and citrus flavours, lemon sherbet and gentle yet persistent bubbles. (2)

Laborie Brut Rosé, Western Cape, South Africa

Delicious fizz with good body and texture. Red fruit flavours, mainly strawberries, and a hint of underlying minerality. Lingering gentle acidity and the merest hint of sweetness. (1)

WHITE WINE

Freedom Cross Sauvignon Blanc, Franschhoek, South Africa ^V

A lovely tropical Sauvignon Blanc. Pineapple, guava and melon aromas and delicious zesty crispness. (1)

Miopasso Grillo Appassimento, Sicily, Italy ^V

Very unusual and complex. Dried fruits and nuts, with hints of oranges and grapefruit, yet soft and well-rounded, with touches of honey on the long and well-balanced finish. (2)

Organic Fedele Catarratto Pinot Grigio, Sicily, Italy ^V

Intense aromas of citrus & tropical fruit with a subtle textured creaminess offering pear, melon and hints of stone fruit flavours finishing with brilliant freshness. (1)

Icare Chardonnay, Cotes de Thongue, France ^V

Beautiful rich style of chardonnay that defies its price. Tastes like top end white Burgundy. Plenty of rich creamy peach notes and buttery softness from deft use of oak. Good citrus acidity keeps it well balanced and the finish goes on and on. (2)

Alto los Romeros Gran Reserva Roussanne Marsanne, Colchagua, Chile ^V

Intense fruit aromatics of apricot and peach with honey and vanilla. Balanced crisp acidity with a generous body and a beautiful deep an complex finish. (2)

Zevenwacht The Tin Mine White, Stellenbosch, South Africa ^V

Elegant and sophisticated, the wine shows quince, white pear and citrus with subtle oak spice and floral undertones. The palate is focussed with bright acidity that is balanced out with a creamy texture on the mid palate and a long savoury finish. (2)

Rioja Vega Tempranillo Blanco, Rioja, Spain ^V

Complex and expressive nose of tropical fruits, white flowers and a herbaceous edge with a good lick of citrus acidity. Creamy texture from some oak aging. (1)

La Boheme Pinot Gris, Yarra Valley, Australia ^V

Delicate aromatics, but with subtle complexity. Fresh pear, mandarin and honey. Soft and full on the palate with a nicely balanced citrus edge. (2)

Delheim Estate Wild Ferment Chenin Blanc, Stellenbosch, South Africa ^V

Intense apricot, honeysuckle, and macadamia nut flavour, textured creamy palate with balanced acidity and excellent length. (1)

ROSE WINE

La Voile Rosé, Pays d'Oc, *France*

Delicate, pale pink in colour showing flavours of ripe red cherries and strawberry. Easily mistaken for a Provence Rosé. (1)

Organic Bodegas Bagordi Rioja Rosado, Rioja, *Spain* 

Fresh and fruity with ripe red fruit aromas accompanied by rose petals and a refreshing crisp finish. (2)

Organic Quatre Vin QV Rosé, Côtes de Provence, *France* 

Fresh, light & floral, with juicy stone fruit, strawberries and delicate minerality. A great example of a brilliant Provence! Lovely subtlety and complexity. (1)

RED WINE

Le Petit Balthazar Merlot, Languedoc, *France* 

A rich ripe nose of blueberries, plums and liquorice. Round medium body with a lingering fruity finish. (B)

Rioja Vega Semi-Crianza, Rioja, *Spain* 

Delightful youthful purple colour with subtle liquorice and black fruit. Barrel ageing gives plenty of savoury spice and savoury tannins all contributing to a very long finish. (C)

Uvas del Sol Malbec Reserve, Mendoza, *Argentina* 

Full and rich black fruits, spice, chocolate and pepper. Strong ripe tannins and liquorice and vanilla over a very long and complex finish. (D)

Chianti Duca Di Saragnano, Tuscany, *Italy*

Deep red colour with purple hints. Spicy and floral with forest berries and cherries. Well balanced and dry with good tannins and excellent length. (D)

Château Daviaud AOC Bordeaux, *France* 

An expressive nose of red fruit with appealing ripeness, and surprising softness with a good depth of spice and body. (D)

Alto los Romeros Carignan Gran Reserva, Maule Valley, *Chile* 

Deep violet red colour. Fruity and complex nose of wild blackberry and raspberry with a violet floral note and toasted spice. Medium bodied with a long and juicy spice-laden finish. (D)

Passitivo Primitivo, Puglia, *Italy* 


Complex bouquet reminiscent of cherries, raspberries and redcurrants. Oak ageing adds a pleasant roasted and spicy aroma. The palate is full-bodied, supple, well-balanced with a long finish. (E)

Zevenwacht The Tin Mine Red SMG, Stellenbosch, *South Africa* 

Complex nose of blackberry, cranberry and dark cherries with savoury herbs and peppery spice. The palate impresses with ample dark fruit and subtle tannins that are underpinned with elegant oak. (D)

Pitchfork Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot, Margaret River, *Australia* 

Clean and fresh with aromas of vanilla and lively berry fruits with rich juicy cassis and chocolate characters, offering smooth tannins with a long satisfying finish. (C)

Porrera, Celler Cal Pla Tinto, Priorat, *Spain* 

Rich and spicy with dark fruit plum, damson, blackberry and spice. Rich and medium bodied palate with more dark fruit and spicy, liquorice notes, leathery tannins and a good, dry, lingering finish. (C)

DESSERT WINE

DV by Chateau Doisy Vedrines, Sauternes, Bordeaux, *France*

A nose of baked fruits and fresh apricots and the characteristics sweet orange marmalade. (1)

Stanton & Killeen Rutherglen Muscat, *Australia*

Deep amber with floral aromas and muscovado sugar. Rich raisin fruit and subtle oak on the finish. (2)
